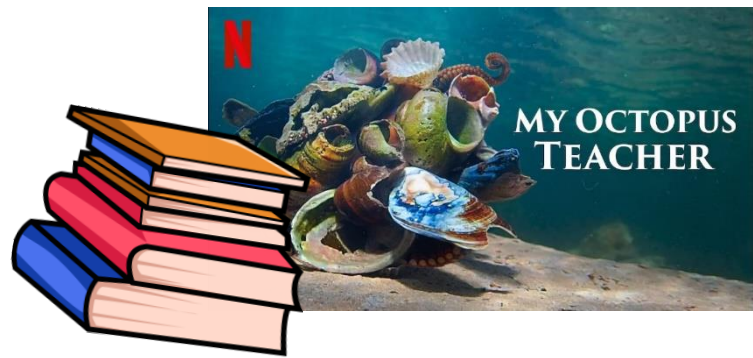

English Revision



My recommendation for this summer is that your child sets aside a set time (minimum half an hour) every day for a quiet reading session. You may create a calendar chart - like the one below - to help your child keep track and ensure that each day he/she is reading. They can do this by ticking each box once the reading task has been completed. You can create the chart on coloured card and obviously change the months to include July, August and September- instead of June, July and August. They may also want to create a bookmark to keep track of their page!

Children, like all of us, may have good reading days and not-so-good reading days. However, the most important thing is that they are consistent (this is done daily) and that reading slowly becomes a habit. Together with Mr. Robert the librarian, I have created a book display in our school library. Here your child will be able to borrow a variety of specially selected titles of books and/or comics.

The library also has a limited selection of audio books. These may help children who find it challenging to concentrate. Children can read along together with a guided audio. This will help keep them focused.

Lastly, we have included a list of documentary titles to guide you in choosing suitable educational films that your children may find

interesting. These should not be a substitute for reading books but may be an good option while children are enjoying some down time.
