Accounts

- Calculator
- Long ruler
- Pencil and blue/black pens
- A4 File Paper
- Flat file (to bring to school)
- Master file with 12 dividers (to keep at home and to keep using the same one from Grade 10)

Art

- A3 Drawing book (smooth cartridge paper) textured paper and coloured paper is optional according to the material used
- A5/A4 hardbound sketch books/journals
- A3 Display files to display all the works
- A4 display files to display loose A4 drawing, if any
- Acrylic paints
- A variety of brushes
- Plastic container for water
- A cloth for painting lessons
- An apron for painting lessons
- Monochromatic pencils (6B – 8B)
- Oil pastels
- Chalk pastels
- Fixative spray
- Masking tape (around an inch wide)
- Watercolours
- Experimental material: charcoal and inks (optional)

Biology

- Graph Papers (20 – 30)
- Blank papers
- Calculator
- 30cm ruler
- Lab coat

It is compulsory to wear a lab coat during all lab practical sessions. No H.E. aprons or large T-shirts are allowed. The same goes for single-use lab coats which pose a fire hazard. Students without a lab coat will miss the practical together with its assigned marks for Matsec coursework.

Chemistry

- 1 Display file having minimum 10 folders
- Chemistry stencil for apparatus
- Chemistry stencil having circles of different sizes
- 1 File to be kept at home for notes handed out in class
- Lab coat

Computing

- Access to your Microsoft School Account
- Tablet and charger or laptop computer
- Headphones

Drama

- Drama pocket poster book (from Grade 10)
- Pen, pencil, ruler and eraser
- Colouring pencils
- Scissors and glue
- 1 Lever Arch Folder and dividers for syllabus notes / scripts / research etc (from Grade 10, unless full)
- A4 plain paper
- A4 lined paper
- A4 flat file for current topic notes (to avoid having to bring in heavy folder every lesson)
- 1 A4 hardback notebook for Grade 12 Learning Log (This is an ongoing record of evaluation which the exam board may ask to scrutinise for evidence of input to practical work. Logs will be collected in Term 3 and retained until Grade 12)

Drama (cont.)

- Unused pen drive for storing music, sound, images, video etc for practical coursework
- A further A4 notebook may be required for a working script, depending on the stage management role allocated
- Students will be required to download and print scripts and past papers as needed
- Files may be kept digitally if preferred

Economics

- Flat file
- Master File (to keep at home)

English

- 2 soft files (one for language notes and the other for literature notes)
- A master file which should be kept at home and be well organised with 8 dividers labelled as per last Year.
- All notes will be on OneNote as per the system adopted last year. This applies to both language and literature.

It is advised that all students download the notes from the Content Library on OneNote to their Devices.

N.B.

Last year's file is to be used, including all dividers and text books. The same system as last year will be adopted for scholastic year 2022 – 2023.

No stationery is needed, as everything for this subject will be uploaded on the digital platform itself.

French

- 1 copybook (which will be used for both Grammar and Vocabulary. Students should keep the one from the previous year)
- Foolscaps for HWs unless they choose to write directly on OneNote.

Geography

- 1 Black master file (from Grade 10)
- 20 Dividers (from Grade 10)
- 360° Protractor (from Grade 11)

Graphical Communication

- A3 Drawing Board with Drafting Head (*Ideally Staedtler or Faber Castel*)
- Compass
- 2H Pencil or Clutch Pencil
- A3 Paper
- Protractor
- 15cm ruler
- Circle Template

History

- 1 Lever Arch File labelled: Maltese History
- 1 Lever Arch File labelled: European and International History
- 1 envelope file with button, any colour, to keep any notes or handouts being used in class.

- A compass (*not sophisticated*)
- A protractor

PE Options

PSCD

- 1 A4 project book (one side with lines and one side coloured paper)

Religious Knowledge

- 1 A4 Lined 120 pages copy book, which needs to be covered with a regular **yellow** plastic A4 cover (use that of last year)
- 1 **Yellow** Plastic A4 Buttoned Envelope folder to place loose handouts (use that of last year)

Science

- 1 A4 copybook with lined paper throughout, covered with a transparent plastic cover
- 1 glue stick
- Pencil colours (not more than 12)
- Ruler with legible cm and mm scale
- School-safe scissors

Spanish

- 1 copybook for notes (students can continue to use the ones of last year)
- 1 copybook for HW (students can continue to use the ones of last year)
