Accounts

- Arch lever file to be kept at home to file notes, classwork and homework
- Dividers for arch lever file
- Flat file to be brought to school for filing work and notes of topic being covered in class
- A4 File paper
- Calculator

It is compulsory to wear a lab coat during all lab practical sessions. No H.E. aprons or large T-shirts are allowed. The same goes for single-use lab coats which pose a fire hazard. Students without a lab coat will miss the practical together with its assigned marks for Matsec coursework.

Drama

- Drama pocket poster book – (digital pages uploaded to teams)

- Students are required to download and print scripts and past papers as needed.
- Files may be kept digitally if preferred.

- A **master file** (any colour) which should be kept at home and be well organised with 8 dividers labelled as follows:
 - Literature: Macbeth
 - Literature: Animal Farm
 - Literature: Poetry
 - Literature: Unseen Texts
 - Language: Writing
 - Language: Reading Comprehensions
 - Language: Listening Comprehensions
 - Language: Grammar
- All notes will be on OneNote. This applies to both language and literature.
- It is advised that all students download the notes from the Content Library on OneNote to their devices.

N.B.

- **The notes taken in Grade 10 and Grade 11 are to be kept in this file too.**
- **Students will be added to a OneNote class notebook and all notes will be uploaded online.**
